



THE AROMA OF ROSES

Several molecules contribute to the wonderful aroma of a rose. Sometimes even very small quantities produce powerful, characteristic smells.




THE AROMA OF OLD BOOKS


The degradation of cellulose and lignin in paper produces small molecules with very distinctive aromas.




2-PHENYLETHANOL




β -DAMASCONE




(-)-CIS ROSE OXIDE
