GOLD MEDAL

Ag SILVER 580 g

Au GOLD 6 g

The gold medal is mostly silver, with a plated layer of gold on top.



SILVER MEDAL

Ag SILVER 580 g

The silver in this year's medals has a purity of 99.9%. The gold and silver medals are the heaviest in Olympic history; the bronze medal is topped only by that at the 2010 Vancouver games.



BRONZE MEDAL

Cu COPPER 444 g

Zn ZINC 49 g

This year's bronze medal is a Cu90-Zn10 alloy.
